

A FAITHFUL MAN SHALL ABOUND WITH BLESSINGS.

Proverbs 28:20



My dad often relayed the story of how he noticed that he was aging. He would tell of how one day he looked down and noticed his hands. He thought to himself, "Those are dad's hands." Dad suddenly realized that after years of hard work, his hands were cracked and calloused just like my pawpaw's.

It was late in the evening on July 11, 2019, as I sat at Edwin Bowling, Jr.'s kitchen table, I noticed at its edge a beautiful arrangement of flowers and a Bible that seemed brand new. (I refer to this as dad's table because he built it some 30 years prior with his own hands. Over the years hundreds of family members and friends shared stories, laughter, and delicious meals at that table.) I asked mom about the flowers and the Bible. She told me that my dad had purchased the Bible recently and given it to her as a gift. The flowers he had purchased and brought home to her the day before. I distinctly recall thinking that dad did a great job in picking out the flowers. That night I slept in his blue recliner next to his kitchen table. The next morning was a weekday, and dad's customers would often call early asking for assistance or for some part they needed on the job. I awoke to the phone ringing and listened as mom answered. The caller asked to speak with Ed, and I heard my mom say, "I'm sorry, but he passed away yesterday afternoon."

The table, the flowers, and the Bible reminded me in that moment that I had a great father. Dad would often offer up advice his father passed along to him years ago. Edwin Bowling, Sr., told him, "Son, you want to know the best thing you can do for your kids? Love their mother." Dad held on to that advice; my sister and I never questioned Dad's love for Mom. Those rough, calloused hands brought the flowers home.

I Corinthians 13:5 states that love "seeketh not her own." Dad constantly gave to others, but rarely, if ever, asked for material things in return. Every year my sister and I seemed to struggle to think of things to give Dad for his birthday or Christmas, in large part because he never seemed to express a desire for any possessions. After Savannah was born, he told me that I was welcome to come home any time to visit, but that I was required to bring "that baby" with me. I know that my sister lived under the same rule after Logan was born. As I would prepare to leave Dad's house after a weekend visit, he would sometimes extend his hand to shake mine as we stood in his driveway. In the handshake he would include some money and say that any time I would drive his granddaughter down to see him, he would give me gas money.

I opened the Bible and on the first page Dad had written a note to Mom expressing his love. It was fitting that along with flowers, a new Bible was one of the last gifts he gave. Dad served as pastor of Willard Pentecostal Church of God for over 25 years. He loved his church members and he served them faithfully until his last breath.

I pray that someday I can look down at my own hands and say, "These are Dad's hands." Not in the sense necessarily that they physically resemble his hands, but that my life resembles his. I want Savannah to know that I love her, and her mother more than words can say. I want my hands to be hands that provide, hands that give without expecting anything in return, and hands that point to Christ through His word!






